- 2. This leads to better populating of your practice's Palliative Care/GSF Register and thereby the Locality Registers or EPaCCS, to improve information sharing across settings as recommended
- **3.** This **triggers key actions** at key times using needs based coding and Traffic light reports for your multi-disciplinary meetings to ensure the right things are done for the right patient at the right time
- 4. Helps you achieve your QOF QI End Of life Care module


### Why is GSF Digital Solutions helpful to you?

- Fewer crises and better quality of care






# How does ePIG work to identify 1% of your patients?

- **GSF Traffic Lights Reports** make it easier for care teams to use the locality register and keep it complete and up to date

- All patients on the palliative care/GSF register

- Summary of care plan
